A) Undergraduate Penn State students of all fields, including students in the B.Arch. program applying to the Integrated B.Arch.–M.S. in Architecture program (IUG program)

- ➔ You must submit a complete application to the Graduate School at <http://www.gradsch.psu.edu/portal> including payment of the non-refundable application fee.

B) Graduate Penn State students of all fields, including students in the graduate architecture programs (M.Arch., M.S. in Architecture) who wish to change their degree program or apply to the Ph.D. program

- ➔ Please complete the described steps 1-3 no later than by the application deadline (January 15th):
- 1) Ask your department staff to copy all documents you submitted in your original Graduate School application and hand it to Architecture Department administrators (Jenn Parkes).
 - 2) Submit three new recommendation letters to Architecture Department administrators (Jenn Parkes).
 - 3) Submit a statement of intent (statement of purpose or Ph.D. essay) to Architecture Department administrators (Jenn Parkes).
 - 4) After admission to the Architecture Graduate Program, you need to file a "Resume Study/Change of Graduate Degree" form to the Graduate School. The Architecture Department administrators (Jenn Parkes) will provide the form and help with filing.
